



#### 95-7895 DASH DISASSEMBLY

#### **HONDA ACCORD 1998 - 2002**

- Disconnect the negative battery terminal to prevent an accidental short circuit.
- 2 Unsnap the clock panel, disconnect the wiring and remove. (Figure A)
- 3 Remove (1) Phillips screw exposed in the clock cavity. (Figure A)
- 4 Remove (2) Phillips screws below the factory head unit. (Figure A)
- 5 Unclip the radio trim bezel and disconnect the wiring.
- 6 Remove (4) Phillips screws securing the factory head unit assembly and disconnect the wiring.







# DOUBLE DIN / STACKED ISO DIN HEAD UNIT PROVISIONS

\*Note: Refer also to the instructions included with the aftermarket radio.

- 1 Locate the factory wiring harness in the dash. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapter from Metra or AXXESS. Re-connect the negative battery terminal and test the unit for proper operation.
- 2 Attach the Double DIN brackets to the edge of the Double DIN trim plate. (Figure A)
- 3 Slide the Double DIN head unit or stacked ISO head units into the bracket/trim plate assembly and secure the Double DIN head unit or stacked ISO head units to the assembly using the screws supplied with the radio. (Figure B)
- 4 Reassemble dash in reverse order of disassembly.
