

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






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Caution




Cadillac DTS 2006-up

- Unclip and remove the trim panel around the radio, climate controls and ac vents and above glove box. (Figure A)
- 2. Remove (4) 9/32" screws securing the a/c vent panel. Unplug and remove the panel. (Figure B)
- 3. Remove (4) 9/32" screws securing the climate controls. Unplug and remove the climate controls. (Figure C)
- **4.** Remove (4) 9/32" screws securing the radio. Unplug and remove the radio. (Figure D)


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


Cadillac 5RX 2007-2009

- 1. Unclip and remove trim piece between shifter and cup holders. (Figure A
- 2. Unclip and remove the trim panel around the radio, climate controls, ac vents and front half of center console. (Figure B)
- 3. Remove (3) 9/32" screws securing the a/c vent panel and remove the panel. (Figure C)






Cadillac SRX 2007-2009

- **4.** Remove (4) 9/32" screws securing the climate controls. Unplug and remove the climate controls. (Figure D)
- **5.** Remove (4) 9/32" screws securing the climate controls. Unplug and remove the climate controls. (Figure D)
- **6.** Remove (4) 9/32" screws securing the radio. Unplug and remove the radio. (Figure E)





DIN radio provision with pocket


- Locate the factory wiring harness in the dash. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapter from Metra or AXXESS. Re-connect the negative battery terminal and test the unit for proper operation.
- 2. Slide the DIN cage into the radio housing and secure by bending the metal locking tabs outward. (Figure A)
- **3.** Slide the aftermarket radio into the cage until it snaps into place. (Figure B)
- **4.** Snap the pocket into the housing. (Figure C)
- **5.** Reassemble dash in reverse order of disassembly.





ISO mount radio provision with pocket


- Locate the factory wiring harness in the dash. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapter from Metra or AXXESS. Re-connect the negative battery terminal and test the unit for proper operation.
- 2. Mount the ISO brackets to the radio using the screws supplied with the radio. (Figure A)
- 3. Slide the radio into the radio housing until it snaps into place. (Figure B)
- **4.** Snap the trim plate onto the front of the radio housing. (Figure B)
- **5.** Snap the pocket into the housing. (Figure C)
- Reassemble dash in reverse order of disassembly.





Double DIN radio provision


- Locate the factory wiring harness in the dash. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapter from Metra or AXXESS. Re-connect the negative battery terminal and test the unit for proper operation.
- 2. Cut and remove the center bar from the radio housing. (Figure A)
- Snap the Double DIN brackets to the inside edge of the radio housing. (Figure B)
- 4. Slide the Double DIN radio or stacked ISO mount units into the bracket/radio housing assembly then secure to the assembly using the screws supplied with the radio or ISO mount units. (Figure C)
- **5.** Snap the Double DIN trim plate onto the front of the radio housing. (Figure C)
- **6.** Reassemble dash in reverse order of disassembly.
