

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

Metra recommends disconnecting the negative battery terminal before beginning any installation. All accessories, switches, and especially air bag indicator lights must be plugged in before reconnecting the battery or cycling the ignition.

*NOTE: Refer also to the instructions included with the aftermarket radio.








Dash Disassembly


- Remove two Phillips screws from bottom part of side trim panels. Figure A)
- 2. Using a panel removal tool, carefully remove the side trim panels. (Figure B)
- **3.** Remove (2) Phillips screws from radio trim panel. (Figure C)
- **4.** Using panel removal tool, carefully remove radio trim panel. (Figure D)
- **5.** Remove (4) 10 mm bolts securing the radio.
- **6.** Unplug and remove radio. *Continue to kit assembly*









DIN radio provision with pocket


- Locate the factory wiring harness in the dash. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapter from Metra or AXXESS. Re-connect the negative battery terminal and test the unit for proper operation.
- Slide the housing brackets onto the side of the radio housing until the clips engage. Note: Brackets are marked left and right. (Figure A)
- Slide the DIN cage into the radio housing and secure by bending the metal locking tabs outward. (Figure B)
- **4.** Slide the aftermarket radio into the cage and secure. (Figure C)
- **5.** Reassemble dash in reverse order of disassembly.





ISO radio provision with pocket


- Locate the factory wiring harness in the dash. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapter from Metra or AXXESS. Re-connect the negative battery terminal and test the unit for proper operation.
- Slide the housing brackets onto the side of the radio housing until the clips engage. Note: Brackets are marked left and right. (Figure A)
- 3. Mount the ISO brackets to the aftermarket radio using the screws supplied with the radio. (Figure B)
- Slide the radio into the radio housing until the side clips engage. Snap the trim-plate into the radio housing. (Figure C)
- **5.** Reassemble dash in reverse order of disassembly.
